Spread of Illness-As you know many viruses are currently spreading like wildfire. It seems to be mostly Influenza A, although we have heard about some other viruses too. Some doctors are recommending 5 days out of school for Influenza, while others are recommending 24 hours without fever as long as the child doesn't have any more symptoms. We trust your doctor, and we appreciate keeping your children home until they are without fever and symptoms.

Many are asking whether school will be cancelled. We had 80% of students PRESENT on Wednesday and Thursday, and 70% of students PRESENT on Friday. We also have 95% of teachers healthy at the current time.

If we have staff, we will continue to have school. If there comes a time where we cannot successfully staff classrooms, then we will have to use an Emergency Day.
